- Students who place into the 102 level of a language must complete three (3) hours of language and will have an additional three (3) hours in general education electives. Students who place into the 201 level or higher of a language satisfy the language requirement but will have an additional six (6) hours in general education electives. It is not necessary for all 6 hours to be from the same language.
- ² A minimum grade of C is required.
- Courses taken for this concentration can count toward the CRJU major.

Note: Fifteen credit hours of criminal justice (beyond CRJU U101 Introduction to Criminal Justice), including senior seminar, applied toward graduation must be awarded by USC Upstate.

To enroll in all criminal justice courses, prerequisites must be completed with a C or higher.

A criminal justice course used to meet major requirements may not be attempted more than twice. Attempts include receiving a "W." Appeals to this policy may be made to the Department of Sociology, Criminal Justice, and Women's and Gender Studies Academic Affairs Committee.

The Bachelor of Science in Criminal Justice offered through the Palmetto College is a separate degree from the USC Upstate Bachelor of Science in Criminal Justice. Currently enrolled USC Upstate students who wish to transfer to the Palmetto College must have permission of the Chair of Department of Sociology, Criminal Justice, and Women's and Gender Studies.
