- 2. Preferred cumulative grade point average (GPA) of 3.0 on a 4.0 scale for graduate coursework.
- Master of Science in Nursing (MSN) & Bachelor of Science in Nursing (BSN) from a CCNE accredited institution
- 4. Official transcripts must be sent from the institution to the admissions office at USC Upstate.
- Personal goal statement (Applicants are required to submit a 1 2 page that describe career goals and how the DNP Degree with a concentration in Public and Community Health will be utilized)
- Current CV or Resume (in addition to their education and professional experiences, to include any certifications, leadership experiences, experiences with diverse or underserved population, paid or volunteer healthcare experiences)
- A letter of reference that attests to the applicant's academic ability, professional competency and personal character from doctoralprepared registered nurses or physician.
- 8. Unencumbered, active registered nurse (RN) or advanced practice registered nurse (APRN) license in state where clinical experiences will occur.
- 9. Must be licensed in the United States
