**AFAM U201 Introduction to African American Studies 3 Credit Hours**

**AFAM U204 African American Culture 3 Credit Hours**

An introduction to the ideas and customs of African Americans including but not limited to artistic, anthropological, psychological, linguistic, and culinary dimensions.

Prerequisite(s): ENGL U101.

**AFAM U398 Topics in African American Studies 3 Credit Hours**

Intensive study of selected topics.

Prerequisite(s): ENGL U102.

**AFAM U399 Independent Study 1-3 Credit Hours**

An individualized, contracted program of work planned in conjunction with a faculty member.

Prerequisite(s): Consent of instructor.
